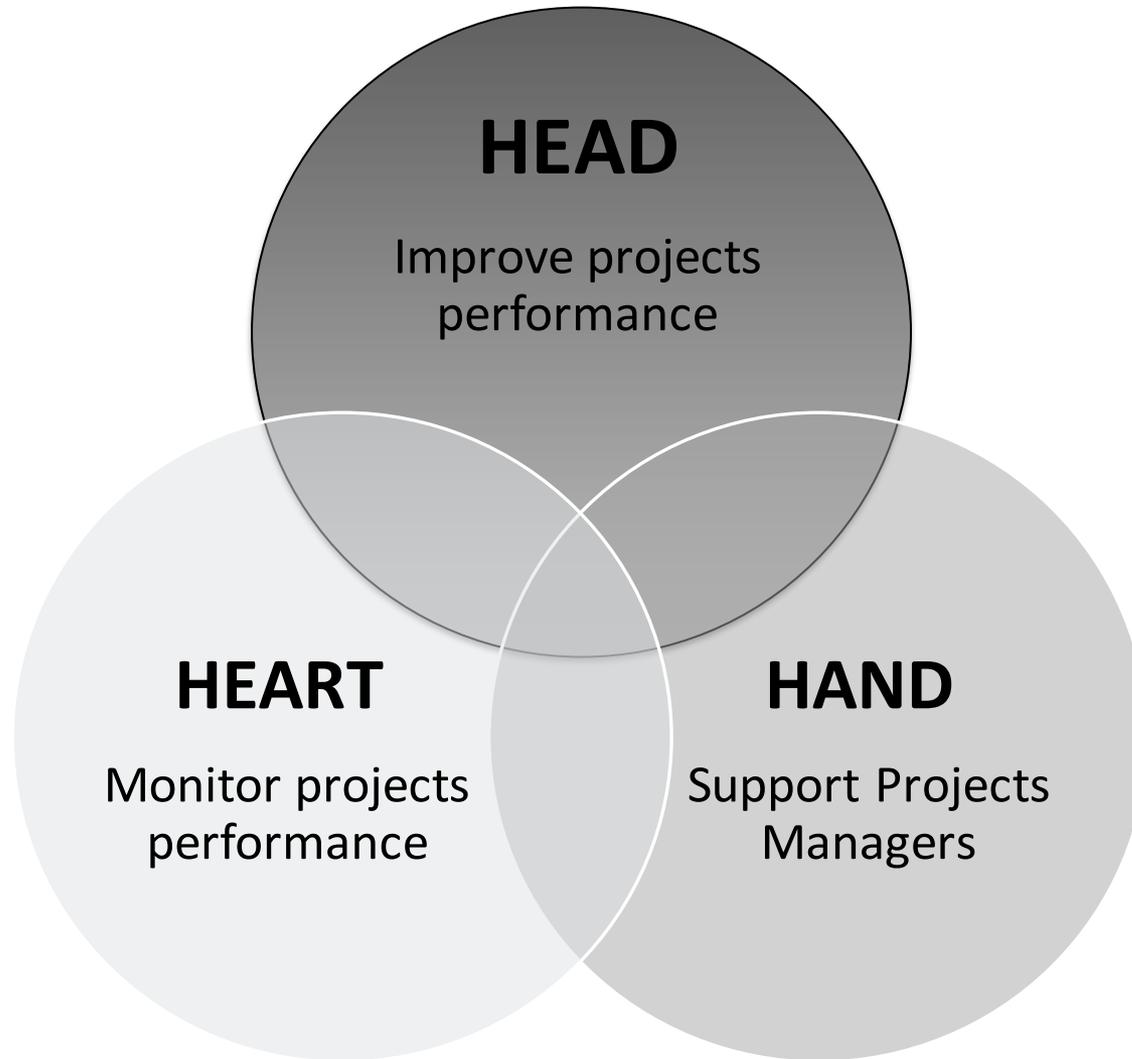
Main Concept
